

## **CAT** (Commons Area Time)

**Ages:** 10 years old and up unaccompanied by parent

**Fees:** \$10 tuition per month, per student

**Description:** CAT, (Commons Area Time), is for students who have more than a 35 minute gap between classes when unaccompanied by parent. Students must be either enrolled in a class or in CAT while on campus. This ensures someone is available to supervise the student. One CAT time in the morning and one CAT time in the afternoon is the limit for enrollment. If a student is younger than 10 years old, they must be accompanied by a parent while not in class.

There is no charge for CAT time if a parent is with the student. This quiet time is intended to be used as a time to get school work done, but students may also socialize very quietly as long as they're not distracting others, as there are other classes going on at the same time in the same area.
