Writing Workshop: Prep to CLEP/Write for Life

In our first semester we will practice the grammar and short essay writing needed for a lifetime of good writing and for passing the Composition I & II CLEP test. In the second semester we will explore rhetorical context and learn the basics of the Classical, Rogerian, and Toulmin forms of argument as we work on our research paper.
