Course Description: In this 6th-8th grade Language Arts Through Literature class, students will study vocabulary, parts of speech, classifying sentences, literary devices, finding contextual evidence to support conclusions, and learn to write various types of essays. We will strive for this goal throughout the year by diving into thrilling adventure stories in the first semester, and in the second semester we will read mystery stories where we will use sleuthing and reasoning skills to draw valid conclusions. By studying these many components of reading language arts, students should become more confident readers and writers.

Homework: There will be about 30 minutes of homework each day to include reading, reading comprehension, and a writing activity.
